The pumpkins are now on display throughout the building.












New clothing items should be labeled with a laundry pen prior to sending to laundry for permanent labeling.

Family members are encouraged to place their member's items in a bag labeled with the member's name. This may be left at the front desk or with any teammate to ensure they get taken to our laundry department.

Anything that includes electrical cords need to be assessed by maintenance prior to being plugged in and also make sure member services are notified so they can be inventoried and labeled.
