### VA Geriatric Psychiatry Pilot program coming to our home

We're very excited about a new pilot program coming to our home!

We're one of four State Veterans Homes (SVHs) partnering with the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) to bring geriatric mental health services to our older adult Veterans residing at CNVH who may be experiencing anxiety, depression, or other late-life mental health concerns.

These services will be available under Section 163 of the Cleland-Dole Act, which was enacted on December 29, 2022. This law requires VA to establish a two-year pilot program of geriatric psychiatry assistance to eligible Veterans at SVHs where it may be challenging to access these services due to location or lack of qualified specialists in the area.

Services will be delivered virtually using VA telehealth technology. This video conference technology allows VA geriatric mental health specialists to have clinical visits with Veterans, their families, or SVH team members as appropriate and provide recommendations to our SVH care team.

The pilot will supplement on-site care to Veterans living in these four SVHs: Central Nebraska Veterans' Home, Kearney, Nebraska Norfolk Veterans' Home, Norfolk, Nebraska New Hampshire Veterans Home, Tilton, New Hampshire Maine Veterans' Home, Bangor, Maine

The pilot will complement our existing mental health services by providing specialist support, including medication evaluation and recommendations, short-term psychotherapy, and guidance for addressing behavioral distress and improving the quality of life for our Veterans.

We are excited to partner with VA to bring this innovative pilot program to our home and are looking forward to the results.
