Legionella updates– As a reminder, CNVH put in place a strong mitigation plan to ensure that Legionella is removed from the water we use in the facility. Our most recent testing was conducted on July 29th and the results received on August 9th were negative, meaning that there is no Legionella traceable in our water. Due to the third consecutive negative test results, CNVH was allowed to resume the "normal" testing intervals which is the Annual Testing schedule. We will continue to test the water on an annual basis, with the next test occurring June 2025, to ensure the health and safety of our members.




Member Council Employee of the Month DAVID CORZO in FOOD SERVICES

Kool-Aid Days Kool Aid Bingo and Kool Aid Stand




Members enjoyed a afternoon of Kool-Aid Day Bingo and some Kool- Aid!

















Music To Our Ears Merrymakers Concert

Doug, a World War II veteran threw out the honorary first pitch at an American Legion Class B tournament game in Holdrege.






Members in Foxtrot enjoyed a Cream Can Dinner! It got great reviews!
