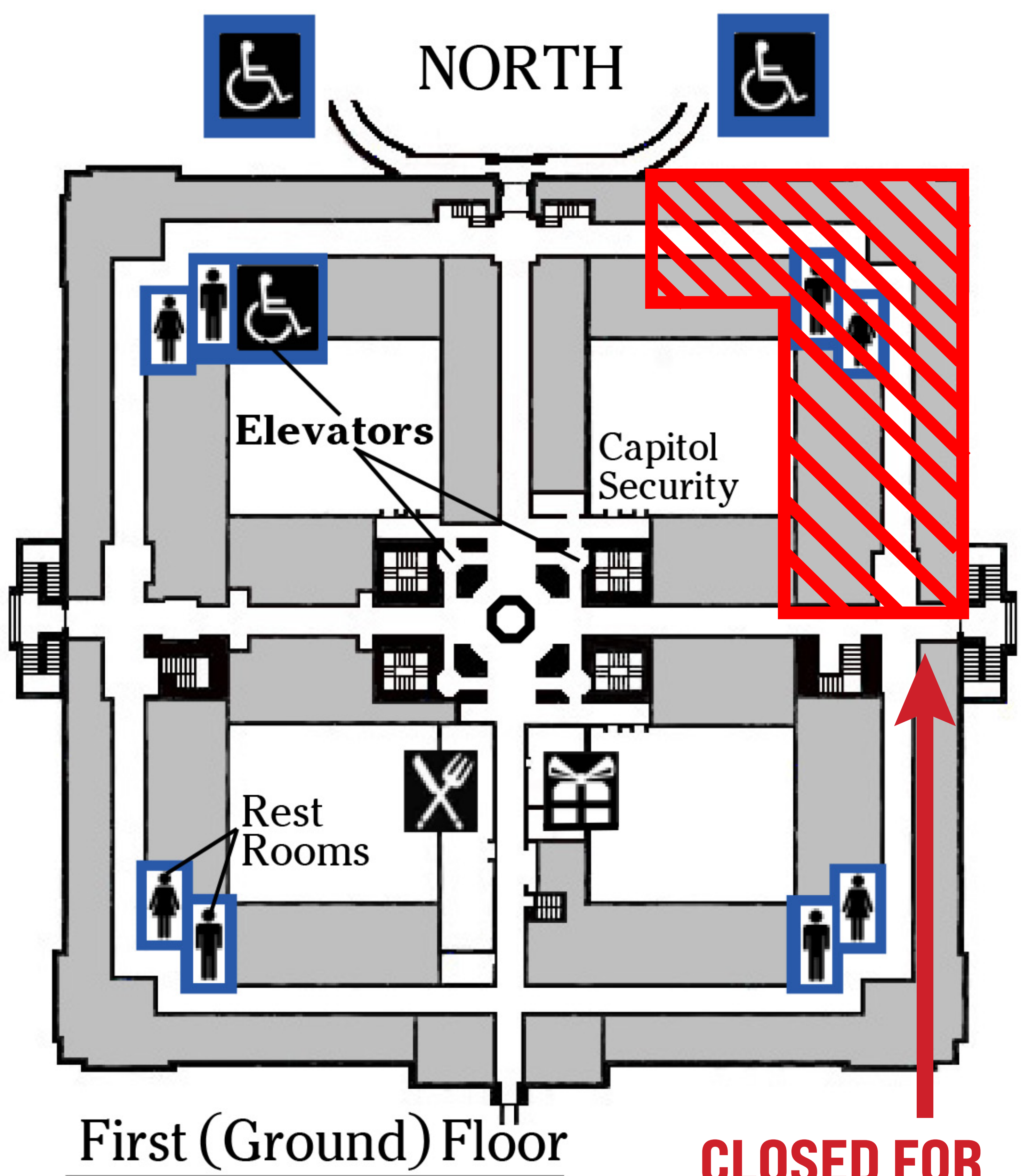
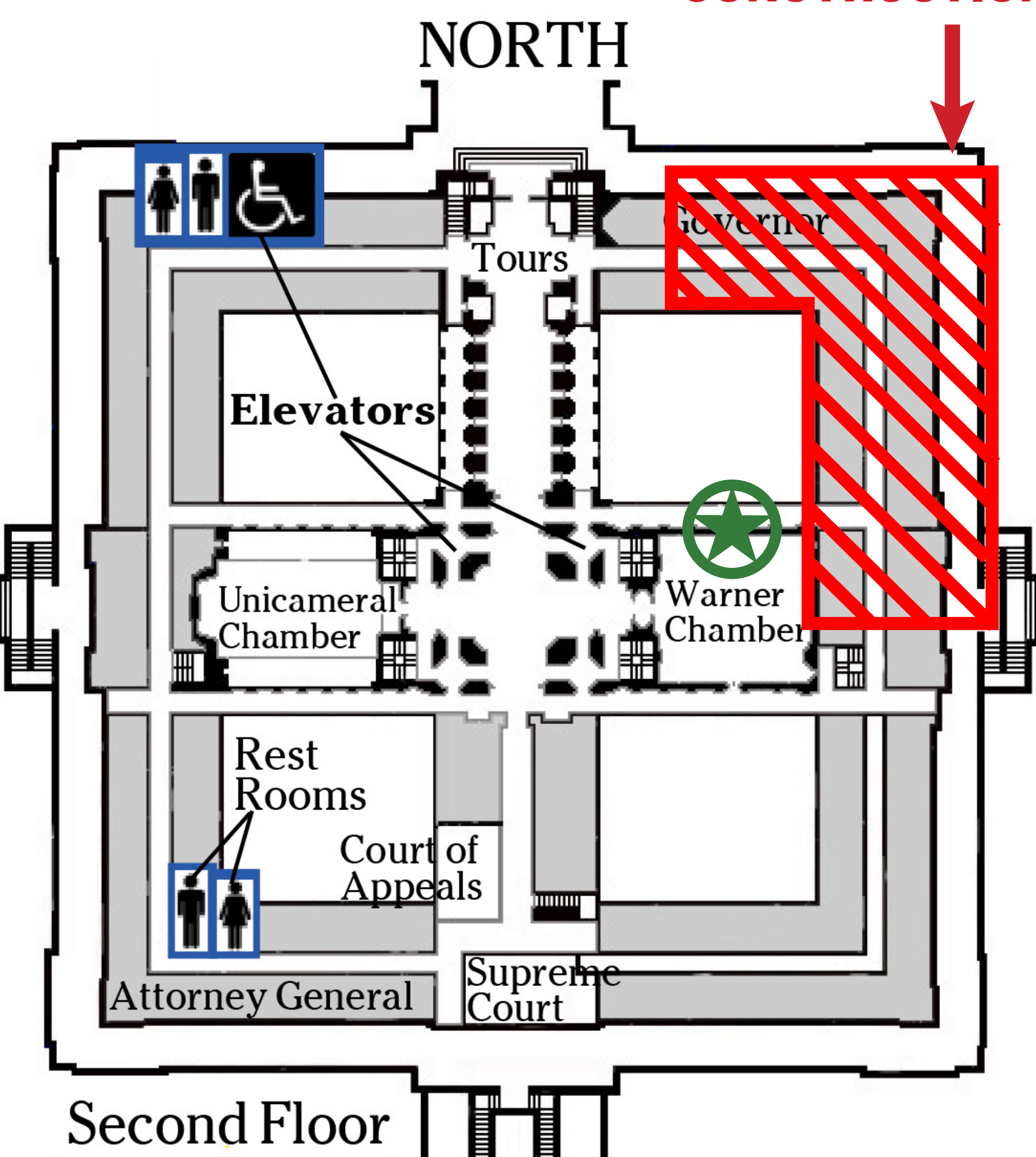


Nebraska State Capitol Accessibility



The north ground floor entrance is fully accessible to those in wheel chairs. Signed parking for vehicles with handicap tags is available on K Street east and west of the main entrance plaza. Sidewalks and ramps on both sides of the horseshoe drive lead under the main staircase to the ground floor automatic doors.

Once inside the ground floor north entrance on first floor, an accessible elevator is located to the right on the inside wall in Room #1009. This elevator will take visitors in wheelchairs to the second floor where the tour office and main operations of the three branches of government are located. On second floor in the hallway outside the elevator vestibule in Room #2004, to the left are the tour office and other functions of government. Accessible rest rooms are adjacent to the accessible elevators (Room #1009 on first floor and Room #2004 on second floor).



For those visitors unable to access the 14th floor Memorial Chamber, murals and observation decks, a 10 minute video of those areas is available for viewing by contacting the Capitol Tour Office.
