Stella d'Oro
Hemerocallis

Stella d'Oro, a popular and award-winning daylily (*Hemerocallis*), is known for its bright golden-yellow, trumpet-shaped flowers and reblooming habit, providing blooms from early summer into the fall. It's a compact plant, growing to 10-12 inches tall and wide, making it suitable for various garden applications like borders, edging, and mass plantings. These plants are native to Asia and central Europe. Most plants are fibrous rooted, but some are tuberous rooted. Flowers are produced in succession in such quantity that the plants remain in flower over a long period of time. Flowers are typically funnel-shaped to bell-shaped, often coming in a variety of different forms. You'll find them surrounding the "heart" in the Purple Heart Garden.
