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# **Occupational Licensure Benefits**

# For Veterans, Military Service Members, and Spouses

The State of Nebraska offers many great benefits to veterans, military service members, and their families. Licensure by endorsement, expedited licensing, and temporary licensing are available for certain occupations. The chart below highlights which occupations and benefits are currently available.
