Activity staff will be serving some fun food items at various events as well. **Happy Hour** sponsored by donations from the S.A.L. on Tuesday, **August 3rd at 3 p.m.** in Freedom Hall, will feature adult beverages and fair snacks, as well as feature **Elvis Tribute Artist Joseph Hall** (a Nebraska native who placed in the "America's Got Talent" show on T.V.) on the big screen.

The American Legion Auxiliary will be sponsoring a **Fair Bingo Party** on Tuesday, **August 10th at 2 p.m.** in Freedom Hall, where members will have the opportunity to win fun prizes and partake of delicious treats. On Sunday, August 15th, the District 6 American Legion & Auxiliary will be **providing Bingo and a Melon Feed** at 2 p.m.

Elwin Dunbar


Members are having lots of success fishing in our lake, pulling out a wide variety of fish! Great summertime fun!!!

In honor of Independence Day & the freedom our veterans have provided for our nation, we had a great Patriot Celebration!






Members also enjoyed banana splits, watermelon, and a special 4th of July gift of either a personal necklace fan or a patriotic visor to keep them cool this summer.


Lincoln Highway & Kearney Cruise Night
