
John attended med school at UNMC and did an internship with Bryan Hospital. John was an M.D. in Minden for 50 plus years.

Grilling Hamburgers










The members enjoyed grilled hamburgers for lunch in August!















Members enjoyed ice cream and Eileen's cookies! The sponsor for this event was the District 6 ALA and Auxiliary.
