Pet Visits on Campus


Our members love it when pets come and visit us here at CNVH! If your family has a pet that they would like to bring with them to visit you we just need a copy of the shot records and a photo.

Members enjoyed some late holiday activities due to changes on the calendars because of Covid. They enjoyed decorating gingerbread houses!








CNVH Library features **"Blind Date with a Book"** In the month of February, stop by and 'check out' this special display!
