Message from the Administrator

Right before the end of 2023, Central Nebraska Veterans' Home (CNVH) was invited to participate in a two-year pilot project titled Geriatric Mental Health Pilot. Out of 164 State Veterans Homes (SVH) in US, four such SVHs were invited to participate in this pilot project: besides CNVH, our State Veterans' Home in Norfolk, Nebraska will

participate as well as the SVH in the State of New Hampshire and the SVH in the State of Maine. Here is a succinct overview and background of the project.

The Law (Cleland-Dole Act of 2022)

On December 29, 2022, the Joseph Maxwell Cleland and Robert Joseph Dole Memorial Veterans Benefits and Health Care Improvement Act of 2022 (Cleland-Dole Act) was signed into law. Section 163 of the law, Geriatric Psychiatry Pilot Program at State Veterans Homes, requires USVA to conduct a two-year pilot program (December 2023 – December 2025) of geriatric psychiatry assistance to eligible Veterans residing at State homes.

<u>Pilot Program Model - Geriatric mental health teleconsultation</u> (via an iPad)

The implementation of a geriatric psychiatry pilot program in state veteran homes (SVHs) aligns with the Veteran Health Administration's (VHA's) ongoing efforts to expand access to limited geriatric mental health expertise via various regional and national consultation models. The Cleland -Dole Act §163 statutory requirements will be met through virtual, inter-professional geriatric mental health consultative services. This model allows access to geriatric mental health specialists who, due to workforce shortages and uneven geographical distribution, are generally not available to provide care in rural or other underserved areas. In addition to board certified geriatric psychiatry specialists, the pilot program will include contributions by geriatric psychologists, clinical geriatric pharmacy specialists, registered nurses, and/or clinical social workers.

Target Population

The target population includes any Veterans with specialized geriatric mental health concerns residing at CNVH. Geriatric mental health concerns encompass a wide range of presenting problems including neurocognitive, mood, anxiety, PTSD, substance use disorders, and distress behaviors affecting a member's care or quality of life. This service will be provided at no cost to the veteran. If at any time you have any questions for me, feel free to contact me by email or by phone. Thank you!

Doug was selected as the "Member of the Month" by the CNVH Member Council. Doug served in the Army and is a WW II Veteran. A foot soldier in Normandy,




Northern France, Central Europe and Rhineland, Doug received the combat infantry badge and good conduct medal.




