LB 93: Veterans' Driver Licenses & State ID Cards

LB93 was passed during the 2013 Legislative Session to establish a veterans' registry and place the word "Veteran" on your driver license or State ID Card. The new law became effective on September 6, 2013, with the first driver licenses and State ID Cards being marked with the "Veteran" designation beginning on July 1, 2014.

When can I apply?

The Nebraska Department of Veterans' Affairs (NDVA) is currently implementing the process to certify eligibility. You can expect to see the process and requirements announced in the coming months. Then, beginning on July 1, 2014 you can add the veteran designation to your driver license or State ID Card at renewal time or immediately by requesting a duplicate license at www.CLICKDMV.ne.gov.

How do I apply?

Once NDVA completes work on the registry later this year, you may apply with NDVA who will certify your veteran status. An application for the driver license or State ID Card with the veteran designation on it is completely voluntary. Those veterans wishing not to participate may apply for or renew their driver license or State ID Card without the veteran designation being added.

How much will it cost?

There is no cost to certify your veteran status. Beginning on July 1, 2014, if you add the veteran designation to your driver license or State ID Card at the time of renewal, you will pay only the cost of renewing your driver license or State ID Card. If you add the veteran designation to your driver license or State ID Card when not in your renewal period by obtaining a duplicate document, the fee will be \$14.75 at www.CLICKDMV.ne.gov.

How can I learn more?

NDVA and DMV are working together to complete programming and finalize staffing to ensure a streamlined process for our veterans. More information will be made available through your County Veterans Service Officer, driver licensing offices and on the NDVA and DMV websites in the coming months.

Reminder

You cannot have the veteran designation added to your driver license or State ID Card until July 1, 2014 or after. The DMV will have online services available for you to do so at that time.
