## **Part II: Eligibility**

- Nebraska Revised Statutes 85-2701 to 85-2705 shall be known and may be cited as the Veteran and Active Duty Supportive Postsecondary Institution Act pursuant to Nebraska Revised Statute 85-2701.
- Postsecondary institution has the same meaning as in section 85-2403 pursuant to Nebraska Revised Statute 85-2702 paragraph (4).
